2026 MCSD Summer School Info Sheet

WHO:

Students in grades 6-12 who failed a course(s) during the 2025-2026 school year.

APPLICATIONS:

The application process begins at the guidance office of the student's school. The student's school counselor will help with determining eligibility for summer school. The counselor will also need to complete part of the registration form. Applications will be accepted through Monday, June 15th; however, students may begin before the 15th, once an application is received and payment has been made.

DATES:

In-person session days will be on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from 9:00 am to 12:00 pm, beginning on Tuesday, June 16th and ending on Thursday, July 9th. Attendance at the facility is not required to complete the coursework. Daily attendance is recommended, since staff members will be available during these hours to assist students.

COST:

The cost for summer school is \$150.00. Payment must be made prior to a course becoming available to the student. Checks can be made out to "MCSD" and can be submitted when enrolling the student. Cash will also be accepted.

CURRICULUM:

Most curricula will be self-paced online courses accessible 24/7 by the student. Some courses may also be offered as an independent study with a curriculum developed by the MCSD Summer School staff.

LOCATION:

The Alpha classroom, Room C207, 2nd floor, "C" wing of the Mifflin County High School, will be the Summer School facility for students in grades 6-12. The Summer School entrance and exit are at Door 18 via the buzzer at the rear of MCHS.

COMMITMENT:

Students must be aware of and adhere to all rules and regulations contained in the 2025-2026 MCSD Secondary Student Handbook and the 2026 Summer School Handbook.

TRANSPORTATION:

All students must provide their own transportation.
